

Tabernacle: The Blood Covenant



Exodus 32: 15-18, 25, 26(KJV) ¹⁵And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two tables of the testimony were in his hand: the tables were written on both their sides; on the one side and on the other were they written. ¹⁶And the tables were the work of God, and the writing was the writing of God, graven upon the tables. ¹⁷And when Joshua heard the noise of the people as they shouted, he said unto Moses, There is a noise of war in the camp. ¹⁸And he said, It is not the voice of them that shout for mastery, neither is it the voice of them that cry for being overcome: but the noise of them that sing do I hear. ¹⁹And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount. ²⁰And he took the calf which they had made, and burnt it in the fire, and ground it to powder, and strawed it upon the water, and made the children of Israel drink of it. ²¹And Moses said unto Aaron, What did this people unto thee, that thou hast brought so great a sin upon them? ²²And Aaron said, Let not the anger of my lord wax hot: thou knowest the people, that they are set on mischief. ²³For they said unto me, Make us gods, which shall go before us: for as for this Moses, the man that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him.

Exodus 32: 25 (AMP) ²⁵ And when Moses saw that the people were naked; (for Aaron had made them naked unto their shame among their enemies:)

Exodus 32: 26 (KJV) ²⁶ Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, Who is on the LORD's side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him.²⁷ And he said unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, and go in and out from gate to gate throughout the camp, and slay every man his brother, and every man his companion, and every man his neighbour.



- Vs 17 Every shout and hallelujah is not a shout of victory or the sound of defeat. Joshua that he the sound he heard was of war. However, Moses could discern the sounds and knew that it was the sound of singing.
- The fine tuning of your spiritual discernment comes according to the amount of time you spend in the presence of the Lord. The more time you spend in his presence the better you will be at discerning.
- When Moses didn't come down from the Mt. Sinai at the time that

they thought he should, the Israelites went to Aaron and asked for something to worship. They couldn't see G-d, and they couldn't find Moses, so they wanted a replacement.

- The hardest problem people have when it comes to G-d, is that we must serve him by faith. Especially when you are used to walking by sight.
- When people get distressed and don't know what to do, they will go back into what they came out of. However, as Christians no matter your circumstance or situation, you shouldn't go back into what G-d brought you out of. Don't go back to what can't deliver you. You shouldn't be complaining. You should be the example of how to go through the storm gracefully. People should be coming to you, asking you, how you weather the storm.
- Remember that the harder the trial, the brighter G-d will shine in your life. G-d hasn't forgotten you or left you. He is just enhancing your testimony. G-d is looking for a people that are willing to go through the storm and allow him to enhance their testimony.
- Vs 21- 22 Moses asked Aaron why he brought such a sin into a camp. Aaron said that the people were evil.
 - Note: It doesn't matter what the people do, it is your job as a leader to lead them. No matter what the people think or tell you to do, you are supposed to follow the teachings of your leader.
 - There is a spirit of Aaron in the body of Christ- When people get with others and gossip, encourage them, and pull them away from the teachings; causing the people of G-d to sin.



- **Apostle's Instructions:** If you can't help someone stay delivered, leave them alone. Don't take them into bondage. For, if you make someone sin, G-d is going to get you.
 - You can't follow the people. You can't do what the people want when they are wrong.
 - G-d will give everyone a chance in leadership to be in charge. However, you must not let that power go to your head, because it is addictive. Power in the wrong persons hand is dangerous. Power in an immature person's hand is dangerous. This was Aarons chance to lead and he failed. It takes a strong person to please G-d more so than the people.
- Vs. 25: Moses saw the people were naked (without spiritual covering).The bad thing about it is that Aaron was the one that made them naked.
 - We have to learn how to guard our families, our church, and our home. Be careful who you attach to just because they look like they are strong. Don't come into a church and attach to people, because there are some that will strip you naked.
 - Don't strive to be popular. Strive to go after the truth.
 - It is dangerous to be weak and to hang with weak people. There is a falling away in the house of G-d because of who you are hanging with. Don't drop your title to be a friend to someone or find a friend.
 - Vs 26: Who is on the Lord's side ?
 - Vs 27 the word of G-d is the sword. Take the word of G-d and kill sin. When you see somebody not walking right, use the sword to cut it out of them.
 - Mount Sinai- Law- old covenant-This is where Moses went and received instruction for

the Lord. When he came down from Mt. Sinai and found the people of G-d sinning , 50 days after the Pentecost 3000 people died

- Mount Zion- Grace- new covenant- Pentecost took place in the upper room in a tabernacle on Mt. Zion. When G-d's spirit filled the upper room 3000 souls were spiritually saved. 3000 souls were born under the power of G-d .

Acts 2:1-4, 37-38(KJV) And when the

day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.²And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.³And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.⁴And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.³⁷Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?³⁸Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every

one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. 39 For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.40 And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation.
